Lodge 8:00am to 9:00am on Sunday February 12, 2017.

Club Aggregate Award:

Club points are accumulated for each race in the Teck Okanagan Cup series and an award is given to the club with the most points at the end of the final race. Points are earned for top 5 finishers and for participation! So encourage your club to attend both days of the Okanagan Cup.

Awards:

- 7 & under (Atoms) Teck participation ribbons for all
- 8 years (first year Pee Wees) Teck 1 to 5 ribbons for top 5 finishers; participation ribbons to all others
- 9 14 years Teck medals for top 3 finishers; Teck ribbons for 4th and 5th finishers
- Tough Cookie Award (athlete who overcame the most adversity during the event, with a positive attitude)
- Wax Wizard draw prize
- Edible medals for top three men and women finishers in each category from 15 years up
- Masters 102+ overall athlete will receive the keys to the community:)

Facilities: A day lodge with a first Aid facility is at the race site. The groomer

shed will also be available with tables and chairs. The day lodge has indoor washrooms. Additional outhouses are located

close to the parking and stadium area.

Concession: A concession will be available in the Nordic Lodge on both

Saturday and Sunday with hot soup and chili for purchase.

Waxing: There is limited power supply and teams may have to

share a connection. Power bars are strictly prohibited. There are six exterior plug-ins available. Tent coverage

for group waxing may be required.

CCBC Glide Waxing Protocol for ALL CATEGORIES

All coaches, athletes, wax technicians, and parents must abide by the following protocol while waxing skis for athletes racing in all age categories. The glide waxing protocol is as follows:

Structure tools ARE permitted

Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted

Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted

Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquid) are NOT permitted

Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted

The adherence to this protocol is self-governed and is the responsibility of the coaches, athletes, parents and wax technicians.

Warm Up/Wax Testing: The race courses will be marked and open for inspection by

noon Friday February 10, 2017. The Lodge and courses are open until 9:30pm on lit trails. The courses will close 30 minutes prior to

the race start. Wax testing on the left side of Main Loop.

Trail Passes: Trail passes are included with race fees for all competitors.

Those wanting to recreational ski during the event must have a valid trail pass. Skiing alongside the race courses during

competition WILL NOT be permitted.

Course Maps: Course maps will be posted on the Revelstoke Nordic Ski Club

website (http://www.revelstokenordic.org/) as soon as they come available and will be posted at the Revelstoke Nordic Lodge Friday

February 10, 2017.

Parking:

Parking at the Nordic Ski Centre is limited. Only cars with 4 or more people will be allowed to park. Drop offs will be permitted. Do not park on HWY 23S.

A parking lot will be available 7 km north of the ski area to use as a self organized meeting area for car pooling. See RNSC website for a map showing the location of the ski area and the car pooling parking lot.
