Eligibility: This is a BC Winter Games qualifier for Zone 2 athletes only. All 2009 & 2010 skiers in Zone 2 are eligible. Top two in each age group qualify automatically, positions are available for Indigenous athletes as well - full eligibility details for all athletes in the [BC Winter Games Technical Guidelines](#).

The Teck Okanagan Cup Series offers affordable, accessible competitive opportunities for skiers of all ages living in the Okanagan. Para Nordic will be included if requested.

Entry Deadline: Tuesday, December 26, 2023 at 11:00 PM

NO late entries will be accepted.

Draws:

There is no seeding for this event, a random draw will occur on Thursday December 28, 2023.

Start lists/Bibs:

Start lists will be posted on zone4 on Friday, December 29, 2023 and at the Nordic lodge on the morning of the race. Bibs will be distributed at the Revelstoke Nordic Lodge on Saturday December 30, 2023 between 8:30 & 10:00 am.

Club Aggregate Award:

Club points are accumulated for each race in the Okanagan Cup series and an award is given to the club with the most points at the end of the final race. Points are earned for the top 5 finishers and for participation.

Awards:

Athletes U7 and under - Teck participation ribbon for all

Athletes U8 years to U16 - Teck medals for top 3 finishers, Teck ribbons: 4th & 5th

Athletes U17 and up - awards/prizes will be provided by the Revelstoke Nordic Ski Club

Waxing:

There is limited power supply and teams may have to share a connection. Power bars are strictly prohibited. There are six exterior plug-ins available. Tent coverage for group waxing may be required.

CCBC & Nordiq Canada prohibits the use of all Fluorinated Waxes for Tier 3 events. See Protocol [Here](#). **Adherence to this protocol is the responsibility of coaches, parents and wax techs.**

Course Inspection/Wax Testing:

The race courses will be marked and open for inspection by noon Friday December 29, 2023. The courses will close 15 minutes prior to the race start.

Trail Passes:

Trail passes are included with race fees for all competitors which includes pre-ski on Friday December 16, 2022, and for the day of the event.

Those wanting to recreational ski during the event must have a valid trail pass. Skiing alongside the race course during competition WILL NOT be permitted.

Pre-purchasing of trail passes will be available on zone 4 during registration.

Parking:

Parking at the Nordic Ski Centre is limited and is open to the public during the event. We request that teams carpool if possible, drop-offs will be permitted.

Please do not park on HWY 23S - Vehicles may be towed.

Race Categories and Costs

It is required of all participants in a Tier 3 event, regardless of whether they hold a Nordiq Canada Race License, Development License, or Associate Race License.*
